Annual Toxic Release Inventory (TRI) Form R

Reports are Due on July 1

The deadline to file your annual TRI Form R is approaching, so you want to beware of changes for RY2019.



June 7, 2018: EPA Finalized a rule that adds a category of 13 nonylphenol ethoxylates (NPEs) to Toxics Release Inventory list of reportable chemicals.



Nonylphenol Ethoxylates (NPEs): nonionic surfactants used in adhesives, wetting agents, emulsifiers, stabilizers, dispersants, defoamers, cleaners, paints and coatings.



The rule is effective for 2019 TRI reporting year with the 2020 submittal **due on July 1, 2020**.





The National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020 added certain Perand Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) to the TRI list.



These chemicals are subject to TRI reporting requirements for RY 2020, with TRI reporting forms **due by July 1, 2021**.



If your facility utilizes any of these chemicals, begin collecting data this year for future purposes.
